Risk: A situation involving exposure to danger, harm, injury or loss.

RiskAssessmentA documentin which the Group Lead(s) and Responsible Administrator assess the overalllevel of Riskin an Off-campus Activity

Risk RegisterA document that identifies specificRisks that may arise during an **Off**mpus Activity and describes detailed mitigation plans to reduce the leves of all Risks associated with the activity.
