<b>Program Admission Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- English 12 with grade of "C" or equivalent</li><li>- Meet one of the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Graduate of a Bachelor's degree (or higher) from a recognized institution with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0</li><li>OR</li><li>Currently in 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of a Bachelor degree program from a recognized institution with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.33</li></ul></li><li>- Package of supplementary documents:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Letter of intent</li><li>Resume</li><li>2 professional reference letters</li></ul></li><li>- Interview or attendance at selections meeting may be required</li></ul>
